<b>CES</b> Community Equipment Scheme is managed by Department of Health and Human Services	North West (Ulverstone) 03 6429 8438 North Tasmania (Launceston) 03 6336 5036 South Tasmania (Hobart) 03 6166 7393 03 6166 7201	<b>Up to \$1000</b> Government gives \$500 towards this amount  <b>Funds</b> <b>Disposable pads/pants/pull-ups</b>	Clients are required to <u>make a co-payment for half the cost</u> of supplies received.  <b>Who is eligible?</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be aged 6 years or over</li> <li>• Children under age 6 must be referred by a Paediatrician</li> <li>• Have a condition or disability resulting in incontinence</li> <li>• have a disability of long-term duration or require equipment as part of discharge planning from hospitals or residential aged care</li> <li>• hold a Health Care Card, Pensioner Concession Card, Health Benefit Card or Interim Concession Card Entitlement</li> <li>• have not received compensation or damages in respect of the disability for which the equipment is prescribed</li> <li>• persons who are not eligible for CAPS or DVA continence assistance.</li> </ul> <b>How do you apply?</b> All clients require a clinical assessment by a continence nurse advisor.
